Recycling is our way of life

Printed on recycled paper  and can be recycled again.

What & How to Recycle . .

Aluminum

Beverage cans, pie plates, aluminum foil, T.V. dinner trays and other aluminum products are recyclable. They should be clean.

Tin Cans

Rinse, remove the labels, cut out ends and flatten.

Glass Bottles & Jars

Please do not break the glass. Rinse (labels don't need to be removed). Metal lids can be recycled with tin cans. *Note: No windows, ceramics, mirrors or light bulbs.*

Plastics

You can spot recyclable plastics by looking for these symbols. They're molded or imprinted as close to the bottom of the containers as possible. Please remove lids, rinse and flatten.



1- PET: Polyethylene Terephthalate. Includes beverage bottles (like 2-liter pop bottles)



2- HDPE: High Density Polyethylene (i.e. milk jugs).



4 - LDPE: Low density polyethylene. Grocery store plastic bags, shrink wrap and bubble wrap.



6 - Packing Peanuts Only

NOTE: We cannot accept oil bottles or hazardous material containers.

If in doubt as to whether an item can be recycled, or if you need assistance picking up large quantities on base, call 257-5481.

Paper

Separate into the following types of stacks:

- Computer paper, 15" x 11" (remove carbon)
- Computer cards - no carbon
- White office paper
- Newspaper and all newspaper inserts
- Box board
- Mixed paper
- Magazines

Remove plastic from product packaging. Only recycle box board (such as paper egg cartons, cereal boxes, dry food boxes, etc.)

Poly - Coated Paper Board Containers

Milk and juice cartons, drink boxes. Rinse and flatten.

Cardboard

Please flatten. Paper bags will be recycled with card board. Any cardboard boxes (other than waxed boxes) can be accepted.

Scrap Metal (drop off only)

Light steel, broken furniture, bikes, lockers, chairs, copper, brass, aluminum, etc.

Scrap wood and yard waste (generated on base only)

Automotive lead/acid batteries

No broken or leaking batteries

Used Oil Filters (drop off only)

Place in a plastic bag and tie off securely.

Household Hazardous Waste

Island County will accept household hazardous waste from NAVY Housing residents. For more information, contact Island County or the Navy Housing Office.


Sales ...
